70th Annual CYO Golf Tournament Rules

- The Entry Fee (early or late) is non-refundable.
- Golfers must check in at their starting tees **15 minutes** before assigned tee time.
- USGA Rules of Golf govern play except for local rules listed at the clubhouse.
- Golfers may take preferred lies on their own fairway: one club-length, no closer to the hole.
- Embedded ball rule in effect through the green.
- Putt out all holes. No strokes may be conceded.
- There is a two-stroke penalty for undue delay by a player. Repeated offenses will result in disqualification.
- **Spectators allowed at the 1st and 10th tees and at the 9th and 18th greens ONLY.**
- No caddies allowed. No carts allowed. A competitor shall not receive any advice from anyone.
- **In the event of an electrical storm, discontinue play immediately. Play will continue when conditions are deemed to be safe by the committee.**
- Each player keeps their opponent's score. Scorecards should be checked after each hole. Scorecards must be signed by the golfer and attested to by the scorekeeper before being turned in to the committee. Any player turning in an incorrect score card will be disqualified.
- The 32 golfers in each division who post the lowest gross scores in the stroke-play qualifying round will proceed to the match play eliminations rounds.
- If a division has less than 32 golfers, the 16 lowest-scoring golfers will proceed to the match play elimination round.
- **QUALIFYING ROUNDS are on Monday, July 27th OR Tuesday, July 28th.**
- Tee times and dates will be assigned approximately one week before the Tournament. **Golfers will be notified by email.**
- Qualifying rounds are played within the appropriate division – no exceptions.
- Any ties resulting in medal play, for further qualification, will be decided by matching scorecards against handicap holes.
- The Committee is not responsible for the personal property of a player.
- The Committee reserves the right for final decisions regarding any and all rulings.
