Catholic High School Leadership Institute

Witness to Truth is a weeklong overnight leadership institute for Roman Catholic high schoolers who have just completed grades 9, 10, 11, or 12.

It is designed for parishes and schools to utilize in creating and complementing their own leadership activities for young people. Chaperones are not necessary as the team is composed of the Archdiocesan Office for the New Evangelization staff and a few other top notch youth ministers, campus ministers, teachers, DRE's, and pastoral associates.

Some of you might remember the old CLI (Catholic Leadership Institute) that was owned by the Archdiocese and run for many parishes and schools. In a certain sense, this is the much needed updating and upgrading of that program and material.

"The 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens" is given to each participant and is utilized as a tool to introduce the Virtues as well as to teach professional management skills.

Interactive morning workshops are reinforced by afternoon large group experiential learning activities that are all processed and reinforced in evening small groups.

Spiritual disciplines are encouraged and practiced through prayer, the sacraments, and looking at the varied leadership styles of Saints.

The result is that each participant deepens their own faith, knowledge, and skills in order to become a greater leader and witness to truth back in their home, parish, school, and community.
